Voice Carry Over (VCO) Telephone



The Ameriphone VCO, by Clarity®, is an example of a phone designed for deaf and hard-of-hearing people. Deaf people who wish to use their voice to speak on the phone can speak directly to the other person using a toll-free relay service and read their type responses in the display.

Features:

- Built-in text answering machine
- Supports normal TTY communication (45.5 and 50 baud)
- Visual ring indicator
- Programmable emergency button transmits user's name, address and phone number in text for quick response by emergency services

People who are hard of hearing can use the Ameriphone VCO as an amplified telephone with the following related features:

Increases incoming sounds up to 26 decibels

Adjustable tone control (600-2400Hz)

Extra-loud (85+ decibels) ringer with adjustable ring volume

Hearing Aid T-Coil compatible handset
