

RINGMAX Amplified Ringer



Have you been missing phone calls? If you have a high frequency hearing loss, you might not be able to hear the high pitch of the telephone ring, especially if you are watching television or are in another room. If you have difficulty hearing the phone ring, the RINGMAX is an example of an amplified phone ringer that lets you customize the sound of your telephone ring so it is audible to your hearing loss. With the RINGMAX, you can increase the volume and set the tone and “warble” to a pitch that’s best for you. Four different tone settings emphasize the frequencies that are easiest to hear. Total sound output is 95 dB SPL at 1 meter. You can use the RINGMAX at home, in the shop, garage, or other noisy environments.
